

Dr. Chiara Riviello was graduated at Medical School at the University of Florence, where he was awarded an academic scholarship of the “Aldo Orselli” foundation. She completed the Obstetrics and Gynecology residency program at the Careggi University hospital of Florence. During her residency, she attended six months of “Research and Care rotation on Gestational diabetes Mellitus Program” and “Completion of a Pediatric Endocrinology Rotation” at the Sansum Diabetes Research Institute di Santa Barbara, CA.

From 2008 to 2012 she attended the School of Traditional Acupuncture in the city of Florence, graduating from Medical Acupuncturist with a thesis on Infertility Torque: diagnostic therapeutic integration between Traditional Chinese Medicine and Western Medicine.

Her main fields of interest and specialization are: management of high-risk pregnancy, multiple abortions, reproductive medicine, gynecological endocrinology from a young age at menopause and gynecological and obstetrical ultrasound, acupuncture in obstetrics and gynecology.

She has considered a career as a physician scientist in research medicine and has published over 26 scientific articles and she gave several congress communications on pregnancy and recurrent pregnancy losses issues.

From 2004 to 2010 she has taught Basic foundations of Obstetrics and Gynaecology for health care assistants, University of Florence.

At present, she is involved in a clinic research project on the recurrent pregnancy loss management at the University of Florence.

She is the author of two [textbooks](#), 5 chapters in books and over 26 scientific publications, including 15 as first author.

From 2004 to 2010 she taught Fundamentals of Gynecology and Obstetrics students Medicare and drafted a manual.

Currently, she is involved in a project on the management of recurrent fetal loss, look at the diagnostic and therapeutic and University Hospital of Careggi, Florence (Prof. Coccia)
